Whenever any local publisher in any language, other than Dutch, puts a copyright in its product/book, it only will apply for that specific format of the Jesus Messiah picturebook edition. Anyone is allowed to take that publication and re-create or re-print these materials for its own distribution channels. It is allowed to use the original text and the pictures. It is allowed to improve the translated texts. It's allowed to add graphics to improve the book for your outreach purposes. Publishers are allowed to (re)publish any Jesus Messiah book or its derivatives in a new product.

The artist would greatly appreciate to get 2 copies of these new products, especially when no picture Jesus Messiah book exist in that language.
